

SUPPLIER COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

SINOHUB — China–Europe sourcing intermediation platform

1. Parties

On one side, Mr. Jonathan Querol Sola, of legal age, holding Spanish tax ID (NIF) 47862568M, acting as a self-employed professional under the trade name SINOHUB, domiciled at Carrer Ponent 8, 43879 Els Muntells (Tarragona), Spain (hereinafter, "SINOHUB" or "the Platform").

On the other side, the supplier who registers on and accepts this agreement through the sinohub.es platform, identified by the details provided during registration (company name, contact person, and payment details) (hereinafter, "the Supplier").

Both parties mutually acknowledge sufficient legal capacity to enter into this agreement and agree to the following.

2. Purpose of the agreement

SINOHUB operates a digital platform that connects clients (mainly European companies) with suppliers, manufacturers, freight forwarders and quality inspection agents based in China, for the provision of product sourcing, international shipping, packaging manufacturing and quality control services.

This agreement governs the relationship between SINOHUB and the Supplier regarding the receipt of service requests through the Platform, the issuance of quotes, the direct provision of the service to the end client, and the payment of the intermediation commission owed to SINOHUB.

3. Operating process

- The Supplier receives, through the Platform, client service requests corresponding to the categories selected during registration (product sourcing, international shipping, packaging manufacturing and/or quality control).
- The Supplier issues a quote for the requested service, which SINOHUB reviews and to which it applies its intermediation commission before presenting the final price to the client.
- Once the order is accepted, the client pays the total amount (Supplier's quote + SINOHUB's commission) directly to the Supplier, by bank transfer or Alipay, according to the payment details provided by the Supplier.
- The Supplier provides the service directly to the client (manufacturing, shipping, inspection, etc.) as quoted.
- Once delivery or performance of the service is confirmed, a debt in favor of SINOHUB is automatically generated on the Platform for the amount of the intermediation commission corresponding to that transaction.

4. Commission and payment terms to SINOHUB

For each transaction managed through the Platform, the Supplier shall pay SINOHUB the intermediation commission generated, by bank transfer to the account indicated by SINOHUB.

The Supplier has a period of 48 hours from the generation of the debt to make the corresponding payment. If payment is not recorded within that period, the Supplier will be automatically blocked on the Platform and will stop receiving new client requests until the outstanding balance is settled.

5. Supplier's obligations

- Provide truthful, complete and up-to-date information about its company, production or service capacity, and contact and payment details.
- Comply with the quotes, timelines and quality conditions agreed for each accepted order.
- Not contact SINOHUB's clients directly outside the Platform in order to avoid the intermediation commission, nor offer them conditions different from those managed by SINOHUB.
- Pay commissions generated promptly in accordance with clause 4.
- Comply with applicable regulations on international trade, customs, product quality and safety relevant to the services provided.

6. SINOHUB's obligations

- Make the Platform available to the Supplier for receiving requests and managing orders.
- Act in good faith as an intermediary between the Supplier and the end client.
- Protect the confidentiality of the Supplier's business information in accordance with clause 8.

7. Term and termination

This agreement has an indefinite term from its acceptance, and either party may terminate it at any time by written notice, without prejudice to payment obligations already generated before termination.

SINOHUB may immediately suspend or deactivate the Supplier in the event of serious breach of the above obligations, repeated non-payment of commissions, or fraudulent conduct.

8. Confidentiality and data protection

Both parties undertake to maintain the confidentiality of the business, technical and client information to which they have access as a result of the relationship arising from this agreement, and not to use it for purposes other than those provided for herein.

Personal data provided will be processed by SINOHUB in accordance with its Privacy Policy, available at sinohub.es/privacidad.

9. Limitation of liability

SINOHUB acts as an intermediary and assumes no liability for manufacturing defects, logistics delays, quality non-compliance or any other incident directly attributable to the Supplier in the provision of the service contracted by the client.

10. Governing law and jurisdiction

This agreement is governed by Spanish law. For any dispute arising from its interpretation or performance, both parties submit to the competent Courts, expressly waiving any other jurisdiction that may correspond to them.

11. Acceptance

The Supplier declares to have read, understood and fully accepted this agreement by checking the acceptance box during the registration process on the sinohub.es platform. The Platform electronically records the date, time and version of the accepted agreement, which shall serve as evidence of acceptance for all purposes.
